Process for the Development of the Programme

- Draft Regional Strategic Framework
- Submission of a concept note
- Action Fiche
- Drafting of the Programme
 - Used the Approved Regional Strategic Framework
 - Feedback from potential stakeholders
 - Knowledge of the region



The Programme (1 of 2)

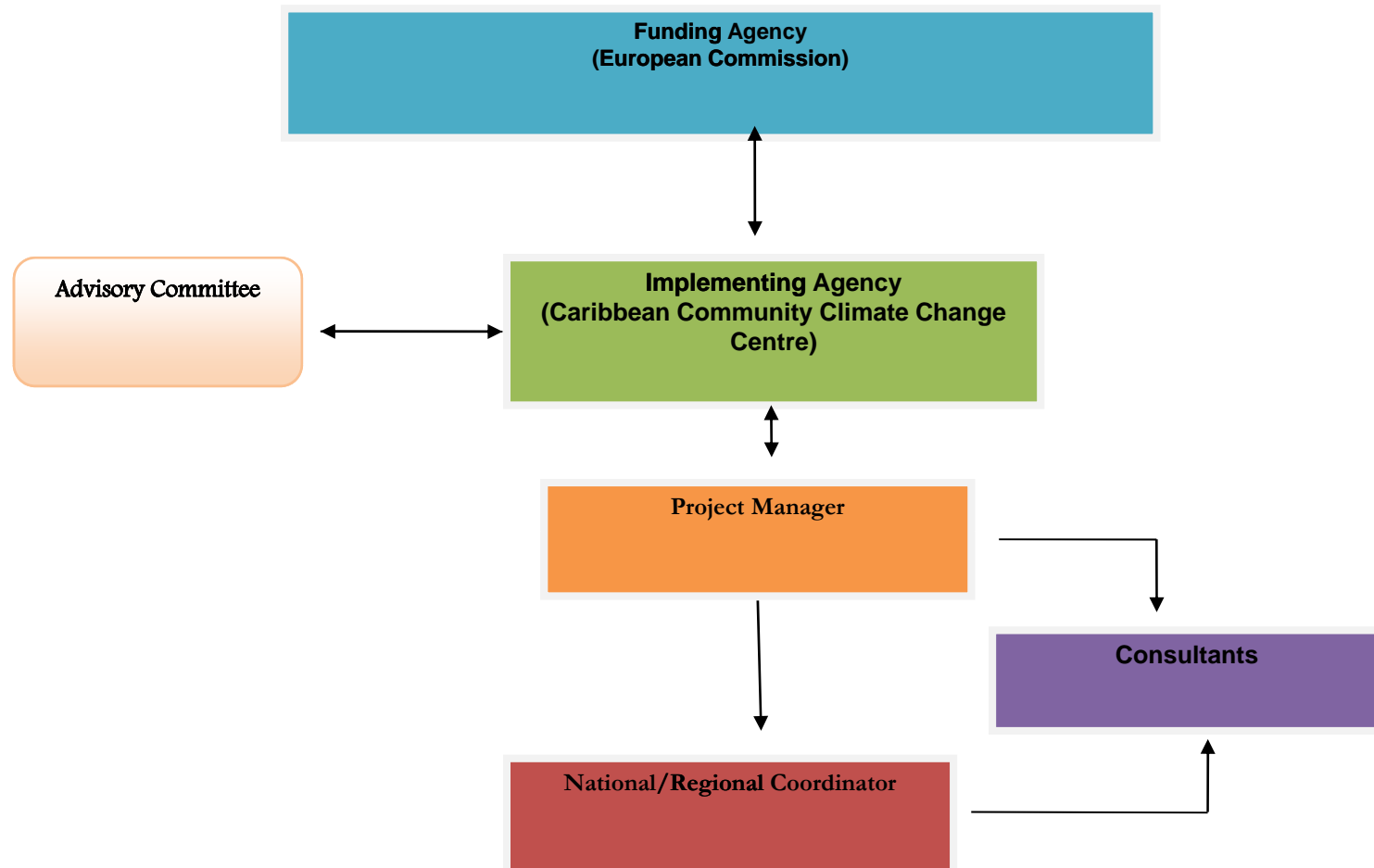
- €8 million over 5 years for CARIFORUM
- Developed around the thematic areas within the Regional Strategic Framework
- The Programme has five components.
 - Enhancing the predictive powers of regional climate models
 - Improving climate monitoring, data retrieval and space-based tools for disaster risk reduction



The Programme (2 of 2)

- Refining vulnerability and risk assessment methodologies that are more contextually relevant, and building local capacity to better assess the current and future vulnerabilities and risks
- Embarking on adaptation pilots
- Building Regional /National Capacity for Carbon Financing

Status of the Programme

- Submitted the First Draft Programme in September 2010
- Received feedback in February 2011
- Revised and resubmitted second draft submitted at the beginning of March 2011
- Awaiting feedback
- Finalise document and sign legal instruments
- Operationalise the programme by January 2012
